- Sometimes (mild) = 1
- Often (moderate) = 2
- Very often (severe) = 3

Assign a number to each question.

Attention

- 1. Fails to give close attention to details or makes careless mistakes in schoolwork
- 2. Has difficulty sustaining attention in tasks or play activities
- 3. Does not seem to listen when spoken to directly
- 4. Does not follow through on instructions and fails to finish schoolwork, chores or duties
- 5. Has difficulty organising tasks and activities
- 6. Avoids tasks (e.g. schoolwork, homework) that requires sustained mental effort
- 7. Loses things necessary for tasks or activities (e.g. toys, school assignments, pencils or books)
- 8. Is easily distracted
- 9. Is forgetful in daily activities

Hyperactivity/Impulsivity

- 1. Fidgets with hands or feet or squirms in seat
- 2. Leaves seat in the classroom or other situations in which remaining seated is expected
- 3. Runs about or climbs excessively in situations in which it is inappropriate
- 4. Has difficulty playing or engaging in leisure activities quietly
- 5. Is 'on the go' or acts as if 'driven by a motor'
- 6. Talks excessively
- 7. Blurts out answers before questions have been completed
- 8. Has difficulty waiting their turn
- 9. Interrupts or intrudes on others
